

TIC-TAC-TOE

Component: Books of the Bible

Set up: Make a tic-tac-toe board on the floor using masking tape. Create two teams with your students. You will need at least ten players for this game. One team will be the X team and the other team will be the O team. The teacher will choose which team goes first.

Play: The teacher will start the game by stating a book of the Bible. The team member chosen to go first, will respond with the book of the Bible before, the book of the Bible stated and the book of the Bible after. If the team member recites all three books correctly, he will then step onto the game board and choose one of the squares to stand in. If he does not answer correctly, it will be the other team's turn and the teacher will recite a different book of the Bible. The game continues until one of the teams has successfully won that tic-tac-toe round. The team who wins the round receives a point. The game will be played again until all students have had a chance to play. The team with the most points wins.

If you do not have ten students in your class, cut out five Xs and five Os for the students to use on the game board. Give the Xs to one team and Os to the other team. If a student answers the question correctly, he will place his team's O on the game board. If he does not answer correctly, it is then the Xs team's turn to play.
